Students should be comfortable to ask questions when they don't understand instructions, whether it be behavior or a learning setting.
Partnership Be Involved	Parent Engagement Nights & PTO Meetings. Also FDLRS provides monthly meetings.	Attend IEP meetings/ conferences as scheduled. Provide students with appropriate rest, medication (as needed), and positive reinforcements.	Students should come to school daily prepared and also folow the policies and procedures regarding safe use of technology.
Communication Stay Informed	Communicate using Monthly Newsletter, Brighthwheel, and Social Media	Make sure phone numbers, emails and addresses are up to date on file. Check teacher/student communication systems daily.	Update email and passwords so that it doesn't hinder the student's participationin online curriculum.
Learning Environment	Accomodations will be followed in the classroom setting to be aligned for educational and behavioral needs. Use instructional strategies congruent with student's planned outcomes.	Advocate for your Student and the services they receive that is outlined in their IEP. Coordinate with staff if any outside services are being used.	Come to school ready to participate in therapy services (PT,OT, SLP) and other prescribed supports in your IEP including any behavior or mental health services.
